Jo White is an Australian painter based in Armidale NSW who celebrates Australian leisure rituals and the rural community spirit through bold colour works that are both nostalgic and modern - a hallmark of Jo's work.

Nostalgia, that ache or yearning for times past, which goes hand in hand with looking at earlier years through rose-coloured glasses is strongly present in Jo's work.

Often using old photographs as a starting point, Jo's works pay homage to an earlier time.

Jo's latest collection of work favours a nostalgic look at love. The concept of love is complex but timeless. And whether it is new love or old it can take just a sight, a sound or a scent and you are right back there in the moment.
